

Floxamo®

Film-Coated Tablets

Amoxicillin 500 mg +Flucloxacillin 500 mg

Composition:

Each film coated tablet contains:

Active ingredients:

Amoxicillin trihydrate compacted 574 mg Eq. to (Amoxicillin anhydrous 500 mg) Flucloxacillin Sodium Monohydrate compacted 544 mg (Eq. to Flucloxacillin Anhydrous 500 mg).

Inactive ingredients:

Prosolv H.D, Croscarmellose sodium, Magnesium Stearate, Purified Talc. Film Coat: Pharmacoat 603, Titanium Dioxide, Glycerol, Talc, Brown Colour

Pharmacological action:

Floxamo® is a combination of two semi-synthetic penicillins: Amoxicillin (broad-spectrum penicillin) and flucloxacillin (a penicillinase-resistant penicillin). This combination exhibits a bacterial activity against a wide range of Gram-positive and Gram-negative microorganisms. **Floxamo®** exerts a bactericidal action on penicillinase-producing and non-penicillinase-producing Staphylococci, Streptococcus pyogenes, pneumoniae, and faecalis; Corynebacterium diphtheriae, Clostridia spp., Bacillus anthracis; H. influenzae, Moraxella (Branhamella) catarrhalis, N. gonorrhoeae and meningitidis, E. coli, Proteus mirabilis, Salmonella, Bordetella pertussis, and Bacteroides melaninogenicus.

Pharmacokinetics:

Both Amoxicillin and flucloxacillin are acid-stable and are well-absorbed after oral administration. Amoxicillin is more rapidly absorbed than ampicillin producing higher plasma concentrations than those obtained with the same dose of ampicillin. Peak plasma concentrations of Amoxicillin and flucloxacillin are achieved after 1 to 2 hours. Amoxicillin and flucloxacillin are metabolized to a limited extent, and the unchanged drugs and metabolites are excreted in the urine by glomerular filtration and renal tubular secretion.

Indications:

Floxamo is indicated in the treatment of a wide range of infections including:

- **Respiratory tract infections:** Bronchitis, pneumonia and empyema.
- **Ear, nose and throat infections:** Otitis media, sinusitis, tonsillitis and pharyngitis.
- **Gastro-intestinal tract infections:** Enteritis, cholecystitis, typhoid and paratyphoid, peritonitis and intra-abdominal abscesses, and biliary tract infections.

- **Genito-urinary tract infections:** Cystitis, pyelonephritis, prostatitis, gonorrhea, and puerperal sepsis.

- **Skin and soft-tissue infections:** post-operative wound infections, boils, carbuncles, abscesses, and cellulitis.

- **Bone infections:** Osteomyelitis

- **Other infections:** Septicaemia and endocarditis.

Dosage and Administration:

Adults: the usual oral dose is **Floxamo** 1000mg every 8 hours.

Contra-indications:

A known hypersensitivity to penicillin.

Warning and Precautions:

Doses should be reduced in severe renal impairment.

Clostridioides difficile Associated Diarrhea (CDAD) has been reported with nearly all antibacterial agents, including amoxicillin, and may range in severity from mild diarrhea to fatal colitis. Hypersensitivity reactions: Severe Cutaneous Adverse Reactions (SCARs), including Stevens-Johnson syndrome (SJS), toxic epidermal necrolysis (TEN), drug reaction with eosinophilia and systemic symptoms (DRESS), and acute generalised exanthematous pustulosis (AGEP) have been reported in association with beta lactam antibiotics.

Drug interactions:

Concomitant administration of Amoxicillin and anticoagulants from the coumarin class, may prolong the bleeding time. A dose adjustment of anticoagulants may be necessary.

Side effects:

As with other penicillins, side-effects are usually infrequent, mild and transient including diarrhea, indigestion and skin rashes.

Skin and subcutaneous tissue disorder Frequency not known: Acute generalised exanthematous pustulosis (AGEP), Drug reaction with eosinophilia and systemic symptoms (DRESS), Bullous exfoliative-dermatitis, Toxic epidermal necrolysis, Stevens-Johnson syndrome

Storage:

Store at a temperature not exceeding 25° C in dry place

Packaging:

Carton Box contains 2 (Al/ Transparent colorless PVC/PVDC) Strips each of 8 film coated tablets + inner leaflet.
